New floor plan to ensure that tables are one metre apart.

Signs at the entrance of the restaurant will ensure guests are socially distanced if you are waiting to be seated.

Sanitiser station for customers to sanitise their hands on entering and exiting the restaurant.

Staff will sanitise their hands on arrival and wash their hands every 30 minutes.

Perspex screen at the till point to reduce face to face contact between staff and customers.

QR codes will enable dine in customers quick access to our digital menu. A single use paper menu is also available upon request.

A dedicated cleaner will ensure that there is an increased frequency of sanitation throughout the kitchen and restaurant during service and also once the restaurant is closed.

Linen will be changed and seating disinfected in between guests.

Servers will be wearing disposable gloves and masks when your meal is brought out.

Condiments and utensils will be brought out with your meal.

Choice of paper or linen napkin.

Individually wrapped straws will be provided with your drinks.

We would request our guests to pay by contactless and card whenever possible.

Staff will have a fitness to work assessment prior to every service.

Only one person at a time will be allowed in each of the toilets. They will be cleaned every 30 minutes.

Details of all customers will be taken as per Government Guidance.
