ARDENCOTE GOLF & TENNIS UPDATED POLICY -9 JUNE 2020

Course & Court Access

In order to play golf and/or tennis, it is essential that the following are adhered to:

- You must not have been outside the UK within the last 14 days
- You must not be currently in a period of self-isolation
- You must not be displaying any symptoms of Covid-19
- You must abide by the 2 metre social distancing Government Guidelines at all times

Booking Tee Times and Tennis Courts

- You will be able to pre-book a tee time/Tennis Court by phoning **07483 307632** between the hours of 9am and 5pm
- Bookings can be made up to 14 days in advance, **by making a booking you are agreeing to adhere to the terms and conditions set out below**
- Golf Tee Times will be available from 9am to 5pm and the fees will be £15 per person per round (18 Holes)
- Tennis Courts will be available to hire by the hour from 9am to 5pm at £10 per court
- Payment must be paid by card only on Arrival NOT over the phone- we can not accept cash by way of payment

Who can Play Golf and Tennis?

Until further notice **ARDENCOTE GOLF & TENNIS** facilities are available to all- **you do not need to be a Member:**

- **Fourballs are allowed to book tee-times- 2balls and 3balls are still very welcome**
- **Players from different Households can now play Doubles together**

Arrival

- Please park your vehicle in order that the social-distancing requirements (minimum of 2 metres) can be applied
- In order to access the Course/Courts you must first book in at the Golf Shop and pay the appropriate fee
- For Golf - you will be issued with a stamped and dated scorecard which you must carry with you on the course and produce on request from the Course Marshall
- Please arrive in Golf/Tennis attire and change your shoes in the car-park. The Leisure Club facilities/changing rooms will not be open until further notice
- Hand sanitiser and cleaning solutions will be provided at the Golf Shop

On the Golf Course

- The Practise Putting Green will be available for 5 minutes prior to your Tee-off time
- The Practise Nets will be available to be used - the Practise Ground is for Professional Tuition only
- Please observe social-distancing at all times- if you need to look for your ball, please allow a maximum of 1 minute and then carry on your round if you cannot find it
- Ball Cleaners/rubbish bins/tee markers/ bunker rakes have been removed from the Course
- All bunkers are to played as Ground Under Repair
- Flag-sticks are to remain in the hole and must not be touched- the cups have been inverted and you will not be required to retrieve your ball from the hole
- Players must not pick up any other player's equipment or golf ball/tees etc
- Players must not call other groups through- simply declare the ball lost and move on
- No course furniture is to be touched

On the Tennis Courts

- Tennis Courts will be available to hire by the hour
- Please do not handle Tennis balls from other Courts in use

The Golf and Leisure Club Memberships are currently deferred until further notice and we are appreciative of everyone's understanding. Tennis and Golf will be accessible to everyone who wishes to play Tennis/ Golf for the foreseeable future.
