For wine by the glass and carafes we use two preservation methods of a Corovin and a Dual Le Verre de Vin.

The Corovin is a comparably new wine access system for particularly fine wine that even the most knowledgeable wine experts in the world can't tell from a wine been accessed numerous years earlier and newly opened.

Whilst the Verre de Vin allows us to preserve the wines by the glass for over three weeks in peak condition. Some of these wines by the glass are listed as they match dishes on the menus, whilst others have been carefully chosen to offer a wide variety for you to explore and experience the wine list.

This wine list is for you to enjoy and we look for it to continuously evolve, there are some wines here that are personal favourites of different members of the team including Scott and hopefully there might be a new favourite for you here, enjoy!

Truffle, blackberry liqueur, liquorice, black cherry, flowers, molten earth, tobacco smoke and 5 spice. There is richness and purity of fruit that is hauntingly beautiful. Refined, powerful and intense, this opulent wine is pure silk and velvet. The supple finish tastes like perfectly ripe fruit just picked from the vine at the exact moment to obtain maximum ripeness. From a blend of 87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Merlot and equal parts Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc, there is not a single hard edge to be found. Flawless and sensuous. 13.5% vol

2010 PENFOLDS GRANGE - *Southern Australia* £760.00

This is a powerhouse, structurally superior to both the 2009 and 2008 vintages and breathtakingly dense, long and precise. The nose has cola, blackberry, and vanilla, brown spices of all kinds, coal smoke, meaty charcuterie elements and a strong tarry, savoury note that speaks of the 85% Barossa Valley componentry. The palate has super deep tannins that fan out through flavoursome black fruits. These are purposeful tannins; they bristle on the palate, tantalizing and assertive yet playful, strong not aggressive. The power here is the thing; this has mouth-coating density and terrific drive, so tightly coiled, it gives enough away to suggest a very, very long cellaring wine is here. This is a classic Grange that will please the serious collectors. A wine of genuine pedigree. 14% vol

2005 OPUS ONE, ROBERT MONDAVI - *California, USA* £620.00

The nose begins a little mute with a suggestion of freshly crushed blackberries and blackcurrants, forest floor, cinnamon and a touch of loam. The palate is wonderfully concentrated with layers of macerated blackberry, cloves, vanilla and dark chocolate. A medium+ level of acidity and medium to firm fine and ripe tannins give excellent structure to the richness of flavours. 14% vol

1983 CUVÉE FRÉDÉRIC EMILE RIESLING, TRIMBACH - *Alsace, France* £335.00

Earning a listing for one of your wines at a Michelin-starred restaurant is a proud moment – so what must it be like to be featured by every single three Michelin-starred restaurant in France (that's 27 in total)? It's an accolade that reflects the historic excellence and purist vision of F. E. Trimbach, unquestionably one of the great names of Alsace and a family business that can trace its origins all the way back to 1626. A complex nose of white bread crust, toasted bread, dried apricots and spices. There's also pepper on the nose and palate that makes the wine more concentrated and hot. A nice, mature, concentrated dry white wine. There's a side of lively, sweet fruity notes to this wine as well. 13% vol

TAYLOR'S VINTAGE PORT 1977 - *Portugal* £190.00

From one of the wettest vintages on record, following three years of drought. Great plum red, vibrant. A wine with great complexity of fruit – berry and spice, dense, luscious and concentrated, yet with a soft, delicate finish which belies the inner strength. 21%

Just what a good young Muscadet is all about. A suggestion of sea breeze over new-mown hay, some mineral cool, finished with calm length. 12% vol

041 **MONTAGNAC TERRES ROUGE PICPOUL DE PINET** - Languedoc, South of France (Ve) £36.00
This wine expresses the red clay hills and shows rich and generous notes of white flowers and garrigue aromas, with stone fruits, zingy citrus and freshness to top it off! 13% vol

Albariño - *Its home is Galicia in Spain and common in Portugal produces their equivalents of Chablis and Sancerre.*

044 **LAURENT MIQUEL ALBARIÑO** - Languedoc, South of France £33.00
Aromas of grapefruit with a delicate floral overtone, the palate refreshing with ripe white peach flavours and a hint of lime on the finish. A soft yet crisp and aromatic white. 13% vol

A complex nose of stewed pears, ripe melon, green apples and a hint of jasmine. The wine has a firm, well-structured palate with supreme balance and a long rounded finish. 12.5% vol

A beautifully blended white with intensely complex aromas of sweet almond, sandalwood, cinnamon and rose petal opening to wild honey, peach blossoms, pineapple and toasted cashew nuts. Full and fat on the palate with a taut mineral freshness and seamlessly integrated oak. 14% vol

Viognier – *A white grape variety originating in the Northern Rhône and which in the last ten years has been increasingly planted. The grapes signature is a distinctive peach and honeysuckle aroma.*

- 065 **SECRET VIOGNIER, VIU MANENT - Colchagua Valley, Chile (Ve)** £39.00
Intense golden yellow with greenish nuances and tremendous brilliance. The nose presents fresh and highly complex aromas recalling ripe pears and tropical and citrus fruits such as grapefruit, lime, and kiwi. The palate is silky and complex with balanced natural acidity, elegant volume and a long finish. 14% vol
- 066 **CONDRIEU, E. GUIGAL - CONDRIEU - Rhône, France (Ve)** £120.00
Three great words: Condrieu (the place) - Viognier (the grape) - Guigal (the producer) - show why the pulses race. Here is an elegantly-matured classic to match its reputation. 13.5% vol

Muscat – *Refers to a family of grapes of which there are around 200 different branches. Most famous for sweet wines but it can produce lovely white*

Intensely aromatic and expressive, with aromas reminiscent of lychees, grapefruit and rose petals. Light bodied, very fresh on the palate, the fruit is perfectly balanced by the crisp acidity and a dry, mineral finish.

Riesling – *Its twin peaks are its intense perfume and its piercing crisp acidity which it manages to retain even at high ripeness levels. It produces delicate, racy, nervy and stylish wines that cover a wide spectrum of flavours from steely and bone dry with beautifully scented fruits of apples, apricots, and sometimes peaches, through to the exotically sweet flavours of the great sweet wines.*

Has the thrilling aromatic tension of elderflower, gooseberry and lime, to give mouth-filling richness. Total refreshment. 12.5% vol
