



Further to the recent update from the UK Government (16/03/20) we have created an action plan going forward for golf at Broome Park. Our golf course will remain open until we are told differently and our priority is the safety of all our golfers and our staff. This is subject to change at any time.

- We can reassure our customers that during this difficult time the resort have increased the cleaning of high contact areas to help prevent the spread of Covid-19.
- As part of the social distancing now starting to be recommended we ask that all golfers keep a safe distance apart.
- As from tomorrow we will be removing all rakes from the golf course, the greenkeepers will prepare the bunkers in the morning as normal. Whilst the greenkeepers are on the course working they will monitor the bunker condition and make good as and when they can.
- Please don't remove the flags from the holes. Whilst preparing the golf course in the morning the poles will be wiped down. The ball cleaners are all out of use until further notice.
- Competitions are currently being continued with no change but presentations will not take place in any form.
- Club matches are going to be cancelled and we will work with the various section Captains to re-schedule.
- Staffing levels going forwards will be ever changing. We will keep you updated on a day by day basis If anything materially changes that will affect your experience at Broome Park golf club.
- The Halfway house will only be operating with restricted hours in line with these demands. We also ask that when open there is only two people inside the halfway house at any time
- At present until further notice there will be no course marshalling.
- Lastly it is paramount that If you have any symptoms of Covid-19 or your family have, we must ask you to stay away from the golf course and hotel
