A classic wine in an iconic bottle. Pale and interesting yet full and flavoursome. On the palate, it offers the sensation of plunging into a basket of freshly picked red berries. 12% vol

Made with only the finest Chardonnay grapes from the Champagne region. Crisp and fresh with rich citrus notes of grapefruit leading into mineral overtones on the long finish. 12% vol

Pale straw-yellow and a fine, clear mousse with delicate bubbles. Exuberantly fruity aromatic, with appley notes. Well-balanced and easy-drinking with delicate hints of almond. 11% vol
-  **7 Gusbourne Brut Reserve, Kent, England** Bottle £45

Aromas of green apple, ripe pear and candied citrus. The palate is fruit driven with zesty mandarin, peach and apple pie. Hints of ginger and mineral notes combine with toasted nuts and brioche. 12% vol
-  **8 Gusbourne Rosé, Kent, England** Bottle £50

Aromas of cherry, wild strawberry and cranberry combine with more developed brioche and fresh pastry notes. The palate balances soft summer pudding fruits and a vibrant citrus streak. 12% vol

 Lovely, opulent notes of grapefruit and peach. 175ml £5.9  
Light in body with melon and apple flavours on the palate resulting in a citrusy acidity. 250ml £8.3  
This is just what Pinot Grigio should be. 12% vol
- 13 **Laroche Unoaked Chardonnay, Languedoc, South of France** Bottle £30.5 | Carafe £15.25  
 Skillfully-made modern wine, with a high toned bouquet of limes, 175ml £7.3  
and a creamy-clean richness on the palate. 13% vol 250ml £10.3
- 14 **Taringi Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** Bottle £34 | Carafe £17  
Distinctive Marlborough aromas leap out of the glass and continue 175ml £8.1  
to the palate - gooseberry, nettle, lime and passion fruit. A pleasingly crisp 250ml £11.7  
finish leaves you wanting more. 12.5% vol

 Intense aromas of rich black cherry, plum and a hint of dark bitter chocolate ending in 175ml £5.3  
a long, smooth finish. 12.5% vol 250ml £7.5
- 29 **Frunza Pinot Noir, Banat, Romania** Bottle £23.5 | Carafe £11.75  
 Flavours of cherry, raspberry and plums. This Pinot Noir has a balanced acidity, 175ml £5.9  
medium-body and slightly spicy finish. 12.5% vol 250ml £8.3
- 30 **Rumours Shiraz, Riverina, New South Wales, Australia** Bottle £25 | Carafe £12.5  
 Sweet cherry fruit with silky cocoa and chocolate tannins. Intense black 175ml £6.2  
cherries are supported by hints of vanilla and earthy aromas making this 250ml £8.8  
a Shiraz worth discovering. 13% vol
- 31 **The Butcher of Buenos Aires Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** Bottle £27 | Carafe £13.5  
Attractive notes of sweet black cherry and a silky smooth mouthfeel. Not 175ml £6.7  
a heavy Malbec but one designed to be versatile with food yet easy enough 250ml £9.6  
to drink on its own. 13% vol

- 15 **Miopasso Pinot Grigio, Sicily, Italy** Bottle £31  
 Lemony-yellow in colour with brilliant glints, a captivating, fresh and lively taste with hints of acacia honey, pear and ripe apple. 13% vol
- 16 **Lion Ridge Chenin Blanc, Western Cape, South Africa** Bottle £25  
 Leaps out of its skin with zesty lemon tropical freshness followed on by more rounded melon flavours. 13% vol
- 17 **Ermita de San Felices Blanco Rioja, Spain** Bottle £32  
 A very fruity aroma with sweet overtones resulting from good quality Viura grapes. Well structured, good acidity and a long finish. 12.5% vol
- 18 **Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie Château L'Oiselinière de la Ramée, Chereau Carré, Loire, France** Bottle £35  
 Just what a good young Muscadet is all about. A suggestion of sea breeze over new-mown hay, some mineral cool, finished with calm length. 12% vol
- 19 **Laurent Miquel Albarino, Languedoc, South of France** Bottle £36.5  
Aromas of grapefruit with a delicate floral overtone, the palate refreshing with ripe white peach flavours and a hint of lime on the finish. A soft yet crisp and aromatic white. 13% vol
- 20 **Secret Viognier, Viu Manent, Colchagua Valley, Chile** Bottle £38.5  
 Intense golden yellow with greenish nuances and tremendous brilliance. The nose presents fresh and highly complex aromas recalling ripe pears and tropical and citrus fruits such as grapefruit, lime, and kiwi. The palate is silky and complex with balanced natural acidity, elegant volume and a long finish. 14% vol
- 21 **Terres Rouge Picpoul de Pinet Montagnac, Languedoc, South of France** Bottle £39.5  
 This wine expresses the red clay hills and shows rich and generous notes of white flowers and garrigue aromas, with stone fruits, zingy citrus and freshness to top it off! 13% vol

- 22 **Esk Valley Riesling, Marlborough, New Zealand** Bottle £42.5  
Has the thrilling aromatic tension of elderflower, gooseberry and lime to give mouth-filling richness. Total refreshment. 12.5% vol
- 23 **Knights Madeleine Angevine, Cornwall, England** Bottle £44  
 Elegant, crisp and immensely quaffable wine from a local winery. It is reminiscent of a Sauvignon Blanc with delicate floral and citrus character. Simply delicious. 12.5% vol
- 24 **Hahn Winery Chardonnay, California, USA** Bottle £47.5  
 Initial scents of pineapple and mango give way to aromas of pear and vanilla. A rich mouthfeel shows flavours of bananas, baked apples and toffee. A touch of acidity balances a note of sweet butter on the crisp finish. 14.5% vol
- 25 **Sancerre, Domaine de la Perrière, Sancerre, Loire, France** Bottle £55  
 Cool and grassy, with a boisterous touch of gooseberry fruit over a neat mineral base, this offers classic character at good value. 12.5% vol
- 26 **Chablis, Jean Deligny, Burgundy, France** Bottle £55  
 A rich and complex wine with a wonderful, fat structure in the mouth and the charming typical Chardonnay aromas of butter or brioche. Harmonious, fine and elegant with an excellent aromatic linger. 12.5% vol
- 27 **Meursault 1er Cru Château De Blagny Louis Latou, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France** Bottle £140  
 Lemon colour. Soft, rounded, rich Chardonnay flavours. Plenty of pure fruit character for those who are not looking for oak flavour and weight. 13.5% vol

Medium sweet rosé, displaying classic strawberry fruit flavours. 10.5% vol 175ml £6.2

- 29 **Laroma Pinot Grigio Rosato, Botter, Veneto, Italy** Bottle £25.5 | Carafe £12.75  
 As pleasing a Pinot Grigio rosé as you could find. It has freshness, delicacy and rose-scented charm all the way through. 12% vol 175ml £6.3

- 30 **Abbaye Saint Hilaire Rosé, Côtes de Provence, South of France** Bottle £34.5  
 A pale dry rosé, made primarily from Syrah and Grenache, showing red fruit aromas. Provence is the rockstar of rosé, but this wine is also ethically produced in order to hand the vineyards on to future generations. 13% vol

 Refreshing and vibrant bubbles with aromas of gooseberry, greengage and pineapple. Infused with a unique and zesty elixir or uplifting vitamins, minerals and botanical. 0.5% vol 250ml £5
- 10 **Eisberg Sauvignon Blanc, Germany** Bottle £13.5  
 De-alcoholised wine with gooseberry and tropical flavours. 0% vol 250ml £5
- 11 **Eisberg Cabernet Sauvignon, Germany** Bottle £13.5  
 De-alcoholised wine bursting with cherry and plum flavours. 0% vol 250ml £5

## RED WINE

---

- 32 **Point West Touriga Nacional, Lisboa, Portugal** Bottle £27.5  
 A high quality wine of intense colour, forest fruit flavours and subtle oak-spice notes. The power has been harnessed into a deliciously smooth style, but with real concentration of flavour. 13% vol
- 33 **Tor del Colle Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Riserva, Abruzzo, Italy** Bottle £27.5  
 Intense and concentrated on the nose with cherry flavours and notes of blackberries and liquorice. Dry and herbaceous on the palate, rounded and mouthfilling. 13.5% vol
- 34 **Huntersville Pinotage, Swartland, South Africa** Bottle £28  
 A superb young Pinotage. The flavours of this unique South African cultivar show ripe plum and fruitcake all beautifully integrated and then finished with subtle oak for a lingering aftertaste. 14% vol
- 35 **Tunante De Azabache, Rioja, Spain** Bottle £29  
 Aromas of red berries and vanilla follow through to a rich palate. Long-lasting and pleasantly complex on the finish. 14.3% vol
- 36 **Côtes du Rhône, Auguste Bessac, Rhône, France** Bottle £31  
 Young and well-ripened, this Rhône red is wonderfully easy-drinking with light berry fruit style. 13% vol
- 37 **Terra Iconia Beaujolais, France** Bottle £32  
 An abundance of intense berry fruits such as redcurrant, blackberry and blueberry. A subtle, floral peony fragrance lingers on the palate and combines with mineral notes and round, silky tannins to give a balanced glass with a lengthy, fruity finish. 12% vol
- 42 **Estate Collection Cabernet Sauvignon Reserva Viu Manent, Colchagua Valley, Chile** Bottle £34  
 Fresh red berries and blackcurrants on the nose with subtle notes of vanilla. Soft tannins lead to a long finish. 13.5% vol
- 38 **Secret Carménère, Viu Manent, Colchagua Valley, Chile** Bottle £37.5  
 This intense violet-coloured wine stands out for the Carménère's typical spicy character with aromas of black pepper as well as red fruits, berries, and a subtle note of fresh-ground coffee. The medium-bodied palate presents good volume, balance, and a smooth texture that leads to a very pleasing finish. 14% vol
- 39 **Trueno Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** Bottle £38.5  
 Ruby red with notes of raisins, chocolate, coffee, tobacco and caramel. Smooth and well balanced, purity of red and black berry fruits and a lingering finish. 13.5% vol
- 40 **Chateau La Pointe Bouquey, St. Émilion, Bordeaux, France** Bottle £43  
Just as a Bordeaux should be, smooth, expressive with a juicy soft texture. A fruity combination of blackcurrant and blueberries all held together with an abundance of silky tannins. 13% vol

- 41 **Chianti Classico, Castello d'Albola, Tuscany, Italy** Bottle £44  
 A traditional Chianti Classico with aromas of fruit cake and subtle spice and a complex yet balanced palate with herbal undertones. 13% vol
- 43 **Hahn Pinot Noir, California, USA** Bottle £49.5  
 This wine's bouquet charms with scents of red cherry, ripe strawberry, cola and spice. On the palate, soft mouthfeel complements flavours recalling plums and black cherry. Supple tannins and a dash of acidity end in a beautifully balanced, clean finish. 14.5% vol
- 44 **Château Sergant, Lalande-de-Pomerol, Bordeaux, France** Bottle £60  
Accompanied by a rich bouquet and structure, its ageing potential is long-lived. The palate is full and balanced with notes of blackberry jam and caramel. 14.5% vol
- 45 **Marqués de Murrieta Reserva, Rioja, Spain** Bottle £71.5  
One of the grandest Riojas - all super-sweet and oaky. The big style emphasizes the intense ripe berry fruit and the busty oak offers overtones of toffee, coffee and coconut. 14% vol
- 46 **Poggio Le Coste Barolo, Piedmont, Italy** Bottle £71.5  
Deep garnet. There are floral notes of dried rose and violets layered over hints of black tea. Elegant tannins and a delicious lingering finish. 13.5 vol
- 47 **Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Auguste Bessac, Rhône, France** Bottle £77  
Châteauneuf has achieved world-favouritism by being as equally spicy and well-flavoured for informal summer eating, as richly warming in winter. A charming, easy-drinking style. 14% vol
- 48 **Saint-Aubin 1er Cru Les Pitangerets Louis Carillon et Fils, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France** Bottle £82  
 An attractive, stylish medium-bodied wine with good fruit on the palate. Fine red berry characteristics with clean, crisp finish, good balancing tannin and acidity. 13% vol
- 49 **Amarone della Valpolicella, Zonin, Veneto, Italy** Bottle £84  
 Intense colour leads into an inviting bouquet of wild hedgerow berries. There is a velvety feel and masses of rich sundried fruit, spice and integrated balanced tannins. 15% vol
- 50 **Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon** Bottle £88  
 A herbs-and-baked-earth overtone to the sweet ripe fruit and vivid palate. Scents of fine leather, cigar box and dried orange peel amplify the flavour. 14% vol
- 51 **Gevrey Chambertin, Domaine Chanson, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France** Bottle £155  
Very refreshing aromas of red berries mixed with spices and vanilla. Well-integrated oak note and refined tannic structure. 13% vol

 De Bortoli Vat 5 is a perfect expression of botrytis: pure luminescent gold in colour, with intense marmalade and dried peel fruit flavours, plus the botrytis honeyed effect. 11% vol
- 56 **Cameleon Malbec Dulce, Tupungato Valley, Mendoza, Australia** 37.5cl £38.5  
50ml £4.6  
 Opaque violet, almond black in colour, typical of top quality Argentine Malbec, but here in a sweet and richer style. Intense aromas of blackberry and blackcurrant fruit with spicy black pepper notes and a velvety finish. 17.5%
- 57 **Pedro Ximenez Triana Javier Hidalgo, Jerez, Spain** 50cl £44  
50ml £5.5  
The colour and complexity of molasses, it is complex, intensely sweet and rich with pronounced raisin flavours. A blockbuster of power and sweetness and irresistibly fascinating. 15% vol
- 58 **Taylor's Late Bottled Vintage Port, Douro, Portugal** Bottle £49.5  
50ml £4.2  
Pungent aromatic nose with heaps of black woodland fruit, dark cherry and plum. Lovely clean, crisp freshness to the bouquet. The palate is rounded, smooth and perfectly balanced. Flavours of redcurrant, raspberry and blueberry in abundance, with a delicious hint of black liquorice. The finish is wonderfully long. 20% vol
- 59 **Taylor's 10 Year Old Tawny Port, Douro, Portugal** Bottle £59  
50ml £6  
Rich and elegant nose combining aromas of ripe berry fruit with a delicate nuttiness and subtle mellow notes of chocolate, butterscotch and fine oak wood. Smooth and silky on the palate and full of ripe figgy, jammy flavours which persist on the long finish. 20% vol
