## **Montelvino Asolo Prosecco Superiore NV Veneto, Italy**

38

This is without doubt the most stylish bottle of Prosecco we have ever seen, and with fabulous fizz inside it, we would describe it as fruity, fragrant and seriously chic.

## **Bolney Bubbly NV, Sussex, England**

10 52

Produced from Sussex estate, this award-winning family estate produces top-notch sparkling wine to compete with any Champagne. Delightful brioche notes combine with zesty citrus fruit, honeysuckle & elderflower.

## **Bolney Brut Rose, Sussex, England**

12 67

A superb vintage, traditional method, quality sparkling wine. A fine mousse, tightly beaded. On the nose a touch of yeast, notes of raspberry and dry strawberry, with subtle savoury undertones.

## **Laurent Perrier La Cuvee Brut NV Champagne, France**

15 80

Delicate and complex nose, full flavour with plenty of fruit in the mouth with a good balance and long length.

## **Nytimber Classic Cuvee, Sussex, England**

96

A palate of honey, almond, pastry and baked apples gives it a hint of decadence. Intense yet delicate, elegant yet complex – it's no wonder it's consistently crowned one of the best English sparkling wines.

## **Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rose NV Champagne, France**

120

Made from 100% Pinot Noir, this is clean and wonderfully fresh with a suppleness on the palate and a lingering finish.

## **Ruinart NV Blanc De Blanc Champagne, France**

140

One of the finest Chardonnay cuveés on the market. Subtle fresh fruit with a hint of citrus and minerality. This freshness is complimented with a richness of hazelnut and brioche notes.

## **Fleur de Pays, Moulin de Gassac 2018** **Languedoc, France**

There can't be many fortunate enough to say that the most revered wine producer in Southern France, Mas de Daumas Gassac, supply their house white, but we're thrilled to say we can.

Delicate, fresh, crisp and lemony, with a super-clean edge, it's a lovely introduction to our list.

## **Fincas de Azabache Barrel fermented** **D.O.ca rioja Blanco 2019** **Rioja, Spain**

This white Rioja has an attractive floral aroma, zesty with added complexity of flavour due to its barrel fermentation. Soft stone fruits and citrus fill the mouth. Pairs perfectly with seafood and cured meats.

## **Pinot Gris, Oast Brook Estate 2018** **Sussex, England**

The floral bouquet develops into a mouth-watering array of ripe tropical notes and lifted green fruit aromas with subtle hints of jasmine, sweet ginger and elderflower.

## **Waddling Duck Sauvignon Blanc 2019** **Marlborough, New Zealand**

This is a classic expression of a New Zealand sauvignon, intense fresh gooseberry aromas fill the glass. On the palate a classic grassy taste filled with white peach and passion fruit flavours.

## **Matosevic Alba Malvazija 2018,** **Istria, Croatia**

Widely credited as the pioneer behind the resurgence of the Croatian wine industry, especially the native Malvazija, we are thrilled to introduce one of the wines of Ivica Matosevic.

A hidden gem, its exuberant, minerally lemon and herb-stashed style provides a mouth-watering delight.

**Domaine Belle Mare 2018**  
**Languedoc Roussillon, France** 45

To keep the freshness and crispness of this classic wine, the Girard family harvest the grapes in the cool of the night. The Loire valley is the original home of Sauvignon Blanc and this one is a true testimony to the quality and style, with its restrained, bone dry gooseberry and citrus style.

**Ernst Gouws & Co Chenin Blanc 2019**  
**Western Cape, South Africa** 26

From the heart of Stellenbosch comes this delightfully fresh Chenin. The epitome of South African white, it's a riot of vibrant apricot and nutmeg, with a big squeeze of fresh lime. Smooth, balanced, elegant, what more could we ask.

**Loimer 'Lois' Grüner Veltliner 2018**  
**Kamptal, Austria** 7.5 9.5 36

Ranked among the very best in Austria, the home of Grüner Veltliner, this fragrantly perfumed nectarine and nutmeg-drenched white is fresher and drier than many from this grape. Bright and lively with a delicious citrus tang, this is a definite 'go-to' white from a lovely family estate that we've found, north west of Vienna. It's not only organic but biodynamic too.

**Blank Canvas Riesling 2013**  
**Marlborough, New Zealand** 40

Produced by an ex-international kayaking-expert-turned-winemaker, this deliciously vibrant lime and grapefruit-infused wine has a hint of honey and a floral note, with a steely dry edge.

**Cave de Hunawihir, Gewurtzraminer 2018**  
**Alsace, France** 42

From the chocolate box perfect region of Alsace, nestled close to Germany, but in the far east of northern France, comes this delicate, perfumed beauty. For those of you who love your wines dry, but fruity, this is the one for you. Wafting aromas of rose petals, it has an entrancing flavour of mango and lychees, juicily fruity, and full bodied, yet surprises with a steely dry edge.

Careful 10 month oak barrel ageing adds soft vanilla nuances to this creamy Chardonnay, exotic flavours & a long finish. This beautifully rounded wine perfectly showcases the producers craftsmanship.			

<b>La Giustiana 'Montessoro' Gavi di Gavi 2018</b>			
<b>Piemonte, Italy</b>			35
Apple fresh and lively, with a swish of scented herbs, this northern Italian white has elegance and style. With hints of ripe pear, meadow flowers and almond, it's super smooth and very moreish.			

<b>Domaine Grande Roche Chablis 2018</b>			
<b>Burgundy, France</b>			46
A true classic; we pride ourselves on finding individual estate wines and this one is no exception. Elegant, complex and poised, with clean fruit, creamy notes and baked apple and hazelnut flavours.

Classic Pouilly Fumé with a complex nose of blackcurrants, boxwood and subtle hints of tarragon, followed by lemon and exotic fruits all underpinned by minerality. Very elegant with a long complex finish.

**Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Champs Gains 2018**

**France, Burgundy**

A stunning 1er Cru Puligny Montrachet, which showcases a wonderful purity and depth of citrus fruit, complemented by hints of gunflint and delicate spice. Rich, mineral-laden and concentrated on the palate, this is beautifully balanced with a very long finish.

## **Chevanceau Rouge, Pays d'Oc 2018**

**Languedoc- Roussillon, South France**

Chevanceau represents the very essence of French winemaking, this fruit driven red is bold in body & subtle in structure, Each grape variety was fermented separately in temperature controlled vats, maintaining the purity of fruit.

## **Pinot Noir 'Nightjar, Blackbook Winery**

**Battersea London, England**

Reminiscent of old-world Pinot Noir, the Nightjar shows elements of sour and black cherries, blackcurrant with delicate hints of violet. It marries ripe fruit with sweet spice and black pepper while refined tannins lend structure through to a long, savoury finish.

## **Bolney Estate Pinot Noir 2018**

**Sussex, England**

This quintessentially British red emphasise how cool climate pinot noirs should taste, well balanced with soft tannins and juicy strawberry's and red cherry's on the pallet. Spice and chocolate notes bring this wine together with rich plumb undertones.

## **Rioja Garnacha Cepas Viejas 2017**

**Alma de Forcada, Rioja, Spain**

This one has recently won the coveted International Wine Challenge Trophy for best Garnacha and Rioja; we have it all to ourselves here in Bath!

Exuding wonderfully ripe, seductive flavours, we fell in love with this wine as soon as we tasted it. It is as soft and silky as you can get, with strawberry, vanilla and gentle oak, all wrapped up in a blanket of rich elegance.

## **Primo Scuro, Cannonau di Sardegna 2018**

**Sardinia, Italy**

A lighter style of red, but packed with wild herbs, red berries and the scent of violets, this wine is bright, edgy and different. It is also the ideal partner to charcuterie.

<p><b>Priorat Mas Blanc +7, Bodegas Pinord</b>  <b>Mas Blan Estate, 2016, Pinord's Mas Blanc, France</b></p> <p>Ripe, dense black fruits, vanilla and chocolate aromas envelope the full bodied, but elegant palate, which is rich and very silky with a long, smooth finish.</p>			80

<p><b>The Bull Ant, Shiraz</b>  <b>Australia, South Africa</b></p> <p>This stunning Shiraz opens with aromas reminiscent of plums and chocolate, enveloped in a touch of earthy complexity. Rich, full bodied and full of ripeness, black fruits on the palate with a long, soft finish. Named the Bull ant due to the South African bull ants that would bite the vineyard workers when picking the grapes.</p>	7	9.5	35
<p><b>Piattelli Vineyards, Cafayate, Malbec 2018</b>  <b>Salta, Argentina</b></p> <p>A striking wine with a deep purple hue, the fruity aromatics of ripe blackberry and spice delight the senses. Beautifully balanced with bright fruit flavours, the palate is marked by its structure. Intense and spicy on the finish.</p>	7.5	10	38
<p><b>Casarena Jamillas Vineyard Malbec 2011</b>  <b>Perdriel, Mendoza, Argentina</b></p> <p>Life is all about discovering new places and new adventures, much like wine. The Jamilla Vineyard is a tiny plot of land in Perdriel, a small area high up in the foothills of the Andes, which is producing some of the best reds in Argentina. Intense, deep, brooding and full of rich, sweet, voluptuous fruit, there are not many cases of this wine, so you will need to enjoy it while you can!</p>			65

Absolutely jam-packed with rich, voluptuous aromas and flavours and exotically scented with blackberries and dried figs, dusted with vanilla oak and a sprinkle of dark chocolate.</p>	11	15	55
<p><b>Two Steps West Cape Howe Shiraz 2014</b>  <b>Western Australia, Australia</b></p> <p>If you like big, bold reds, then this one really stands up to the test, and then some. Jam-packed with rich, voluptuous dark fruit and hints of mocha and spice, this is sure to bring a smile even after the toughest of days.</p>			60
<p><b>Domaine de la Solitude, Châteauneuf-du-pape</b>  <b>Rouge 2016, Rhône, France</b></p> <p>A rich opulent red with heavy blackcurrant aromas, full bodied but soft in texture this wine retains classic characteristic elegance whilst embracing a modern style of winemaking. Ripe fruits combine with notes of cocoa and cherry and a touch of liquorice on the finish.</p>			85

<p><b>Bolney Estate Rose 2018, Sussex, England</b></p> <p>This lovely medium dry rose produced in Sussex is predominately made from Pinot Noir grapes. Flavours of strawberries, raspberries and pear make this an elegant summer wine.</p>	7.5	10	40
