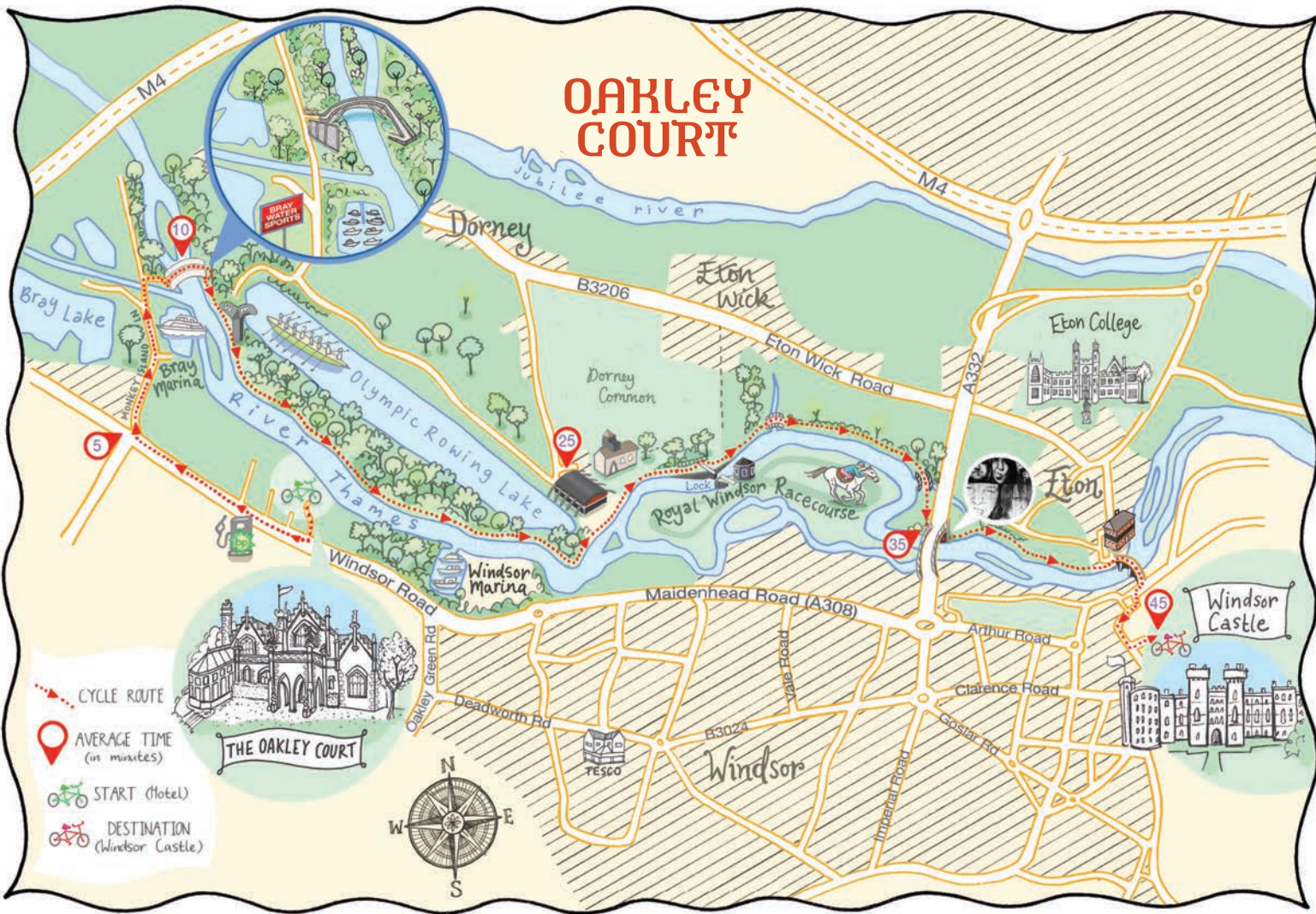


# OAKLEY COURT

## From Oakley Court Hotel to Windsor Castle

- To access the river take the 4th turning on the right after exiting the Hotel, which is named Monkey Island Lane.
- Once you have passed the entrance for Bray Water Sports you will be cycling along a pedestrian bridle path. After about 200 yards you will see a metal gate on your right hand side, which marks the entrance to a narrow footpath. Take this turning and cycle along the footpath, and this will lead you to the bridge over the river.
- Along the river bank, about 600 yards after you have crossed the bridge, there is a National Cycle Network signpost that is somewhat misleading - it indicates that Windsor is 5 miles to the left and Maidenhead is 3 miles to the right. You do have the option to take the left turning here and cycle around Eton Dorney (which is a longer route than the one indicated on the map) however if you wish to cycle the route we recommend, please continue along the river bank.
- Please be aware that if you decide to return to the Hotel through Windsor and along the A308, you will cycle past busy roads and there may not always be a cycle path available.
