¼ Finances	S.M – On payroll there has been a £12,000 saving, some by control and some by furlough. Due to the way payroll works only two weeks of furlough here £28,000 saving of controllables over the course of the ¼ The costs / disbursements, not a lot of invoices have come through. We are waiting on companies going back to work and suppling the invoices for the year.			
	This will all contribute to the 10% fee deduction next year.

Trustee	D.C – Seasons Holidays plc for the last 20years have used a trustee company called Hutchinson Trustees Limited. Historically			

	consolidated the trusteeship with Hutchinson Trustees Limited, and the same applies to Belton Woods Womble Bond Dickinson are the current Trustee for both Belton & Slaley Hall, and in our discussions with them, they have now provided us with their Notice on intention to retire as Trustee for Belton Woods Owners' Club. So, I propose and table a motion to accept the Notice from Womble Bond Dickinson, and to appoint Hutchinson Trustees Limited, with effect from as soon as is reasonably possible. We do need approval from the committee of Belton Woods Owners' Club, and we ask for a show of hands accordingly. Secondly, for the debt of 2 and 2 year+, I would like to use Clause 23, (iii) in the constitution were the Management Company give a 30 notice of cancellation of their Membership, if payment is not received - I don't think for one minute this debt is collectable.

S.K - My other suggestion is to do with the Club Owned weeks — we as a Management Company would be happy to take these from the Club and take them on as Management owed weeks — we would become responsible for the management fees on these weeks. We could do with the extra space, particularly with replacement weeks due to Covid.
