Bread (g*) Sourdough, seasalt curried butter

Chalkstream trout Fennel bhaji, curried mussel sauce, mango relish, wilted spinach

2022 Estate Chardonnay, De Martino – Chile 13% 125ml

Chardonnay is the third most widely planted grape variety in the world and the Chilean chardonnays thrive in the cooler climate. Pairing well with the trout, it brings a fresh, crisp acidity, which balances with the tropical fruit in the relish.

Asparagus

Grilled English asparagus, basil paneer tikka, coriander chutney

2017 Vermentino, Cala Silente, Santadi – Italy 13.5% 125ml

Asparagus signals spring and we've chosen this vermentino from Sardinia to perfectly complement the intense flavours. Vermentino grapes love the sun yet retain their natural acidity, making this the perfect match for dishes with aromatic spices.

Duck (g*)

Spiced Gressingham duck supreme, confit leg & beetroot tart, spiced glaze

2021 Fleurie La Bonne Dame, Louis Tête – France 13% 125ml

The gamay grape is most associated with the Beaujolais region, just south of Burgundy and wines from the village of Fleurie are a delight to the senses: fragrant, floral, silky and charming. With just a touch of spiciness, this lighter wine will pair beautifully.

Beef (g*)

Hereford beef, carrot, black garlic purée, brisket cannelloni, truffle potato cream, merlot jus


2016 Grande Reserve Red, Ixsir – Lebanon 13.5% 125ml
