If you are feeling energetic, there's the walk up 923-foot Abberley Hill – where the panoramic views reward the effort, or the five-mile Abberley circular walk, giving a flavour of the stunning scenery in this part of the world.

Worcester Cathedral, set on the banks of the river Severn, is only 12 miles away, and the magnificent Italianate mansion, Witley Court, is on the doorstep – so there's plenty to see and do if you fancy an overnight stay.
