

# Tregenna Castle Drone Policy

Please provide the following:

1. A description of the purpose of the flight(s)
2. A copy of your public liability insurance (minimum £5 million)
3. A copy of your flight plan including launch and landing points
4. A copy of the risk assessment
5. A copy of the drone license (permission for commercial operations from CAA)

A person shall not wilfully obstruct, disturb, interrupt, or annoy any other person in the proper use of the grounds, or wilfully obstruct, disturb, or interrupt any staff of Tregenna Castle in the proper execution of his or her duty.

The person in charge of a small unmanned aircraft must maintain direct, unaided visual contact with the aircraft sufficient to monitor its flight path in relation to other aircraft, persons, vehicles, vessels and structures for the purpose of avoiding collisions.

Follow community-based safety guidelines as prescribed by organizations including the Academy of Model Aeronautics, AUVSI and Small UAV Coalition.

Fly no higher than 400 feet and remain below any surrounding obstacles when possible.

Keep your sUAS in eyesight at all times, and use an observer to assist if needed.

Remain clear of and do not interfere with manned aircraft operations. You must see and avoid other aircraft and obstacles at all times.

Do not intentionally fly over unprotected people or moving vehicles, and remain at least 25 feet away from individuals and vulnerable property.

Do not fly in adverse weather conditions such as in high winds or reduced visibility.

Do not fly under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Ensure the operating environment is safe and that the operator is competent and proficient in the operation of the sUAS.

Check and follow all local laws and ordinances before flying over private property.

Do not conduct surveillance or photograph persons in areas where there is an expectation of privacy without the individual's permission (see AMA's privacy policy).

Drones should not be equipped with weapons
