

# WINE LIST

## Fizz

**100 Los Haroldos Brut Sparkling - Argentina £27**

Appealing aromas of tropical fruits, peaches and grapefruit. A fresh sparkling wine that is fruity and elegant with fine bubbles and a long finish.

**101 Ayala Brut Majeur - Champagne £45**

An excellent Champagne and great value. This quality minded Champagne house was bought by Bollinger in 2005. It has a wonderfully fine mousse, is well balanced, has finesse and complexity.

**102 Bollinger Special Cuvee - Champagne £65**

Bollinger is made from first-run juice only, and the majority of vineyards used have Premier and Grand Cru status, resulting in a full-bodied Champagne of great class. Delightful pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent.

## White Wines

**103 Bella Modella Pinot Grigio - Italy £21 £5.25 175ml / £7.25 250ml**

Made with grapes grown in the Abruzzo region of Italy that sits alongside the Adriatic coast. Gentle aromatics and a lively palate, with hints of honey and almonds given interest by delicate herbal notes, and with a refreshing acidity.

**104 The Gavel Chardonnay - Australia £21 £5.15 175ml / £7.00 250ml**

This vibrant Chardonnay exhibits lifted tropical fruit character, a bright palate and a long and foodie finish.

**105 Los Haroldos Viognier - Argentina £21**

Peach and apricot with some floral and aromatic notes. The palate is complex, fresh and unctuous with a lingering finish.

**106 Emiliana Reserva Sauvignon Blanc (organic) - Chile £21**

The complex nose presents citrusy and grapefruit and lime notes with a subtle touch of white pepper and delicate herbs. The smooth palate bursts with freshness balanced by good volume and persistence.

**107 Florensac Picpoul de Pinet - France £26**

With its zesty citrus notes and crisp acidity (picpoul literally translates as lip-stinger), it will come as no surprise that seafood and shellfish is a winning food pairing.

**109 Sepp Gruner Veltliner (Organic) - Austria £26**

Delicate aromas of pear, kiwi, apricot and white spice. On the palate stone fruit flavours lead to gently textured, mineral and citrus finish.

**110 Gavi di Gavi Nuovo Quadro - Italy £35**

An enticing nose of white peach and pear with hints of fresh lime and gooseberry. Fresh and zesty citrus notes and ripe peachy characters.

**111 Two Rivers Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand £35**

Established in 2004, Two Rivers of Marlborough takes its name from the iconic rivers that feed the wine growing heart of Marlborough's renowned Wairau and Awatere Valleys.

Classy, refined Kiwi sauvignon.

**112 William Fevre Petit Chablis - France £35**

A wonderfully fresh, floral, fruity wine - an excellent Chardonnay from this revered Burgundian wine grower.

**114 Valenciso Rioja Blanco Barrica - Spain £38**

Complex aromas combining floral characters with preserved lemon and gently smoky notes. The palate is intense and broad with nuts, stone fruit, minerality and balancing citrus acidity on the finish.

## Rosé Wines

**115 Los Haroldos Malbec Rosé - Argentina £23**

A medium rose, lovely and ripe full of summer fruits and strawberries.

**116 Chateau Routas Provence Rosé - France £28**

Classic Provence - bone dry with a fabulous minerality and that super pale colour.

## Red Wine

**117 La Grupa Malbec - Argentina £21 £5.25 175ml / £7.25 250ml**

Argentinean Malbec is now one of the go-to wines, and with grilled meats it's a match made in heaven. This is a real crowd pleaser.

**118 False Bay Bush Vine Pinotage - South Africa £24 £6.10 175ml / £8.20 250ml**

South Africa's indigenous grape variety is richly-fruited, yet savoury and satisfying. Plummy aromas and a touch of time in oak barrel - a richer wine than the Malbec (above).

**119 Messeri Negroamaro/Primitivo - Italy £21**

Intense ruby red colour with purple highlights. The bouquet is complex and rich with hints of ripe fruits and spices. Excellent body and structure.

**120 Last Stand Shiraz - Australia £21**

Warm, soft and luscious, this is smooth, dark and sultry! Premium quality fruit and mature vines have produced a wine with great balance, length and fruit intensity.

**121 Patria Nueva Reserva - Chili £21**

**Cabernet Sauvignon**

Intense nose of dark cherry, strawberry, cedar and liquorice. Juicy and rounded on the palate with firm tannins that combine well with dark fruits, prunes and roasted nuts with toasty finish.

**122 Baccolo Rosso Appasimento - Italy £26**

Medium-bodied Veneto red achieves its rich, spicy flavour by partial natural air-drying of the grapes (a mix of merlot and corvina). The result is rounded and flavoursome.

**123 Bodegas Manzanos Crianza Rioja - Spain £28**

Aromatic and intense, lovely aromas of wild red berries blossom nutmeg and hints of sandalwood. Fresh fruity and well balanced with sensations of raspberries vanilla and cinnamon.

**124 Los Haroldos oak aged Malbec - Argentina £28**

Los Haroldos Roble Malbec is a classic, rich, intensely fruity Malbec from high altitude vineyards. Ripe fruit, smoke and chocolate on the nose with fleshy blackberry fruit.

**125 Nostros Gran Reserva Merlot - Chili £28**

This is made from the finest selection of grapes and is aged in oak barrels. Deep, concentrated plums with a hint of mint and chocolate. It's supple and satisfying.

**126 Verum Pinot Noir - Argentina - £35**

Verum means true, and Verum Pinot Noir is true to the terroir of Patagonia. Elegant, pure ripe cherry and redcurrant fruit with earthy notes and fine tannins.

**127 'Les Coteaux Schisteux', Séguret - France - £38**

**Côtes du Rhône Villages**

The nose is explosive, plush and opulent, layered with cracked black pepper and of course streaked with vanilla. The palate is instantly appealing, polished and smooth.

**128 The Crusher Cabernet Sauvignon - U.S.A. £38**

Aromatics of blackberry, tree-ripened fig, toasted cedar and hints of mocha - all the way from the sunny vineyards of California.

**130 Bethany Estate Shiraz - Australia £45**

Deep, vibrant red black in colour and showing a wonderful bouquet of dark forest fruits. The plate is elegant yet full flavoured whilst the lingering finish is a delightful blend of varietal fruit, spicy overtones and subtle oak integration.

**131 Chateau du Milon Saint Emilion grand cru France 45**

Pretty with lovely fruit aromas of damsons and a hint of strawberry. Nicely balanced structure with good concentration and depth which carries through to the long finish.

**132 Pierre Bouree Cotes du Beaune Villages - France £55**

Offering authentic Pinot flavours, this Burgundy is very attractive; lightly smoky with red fruits and vegetal earthiness. Well structured and nicely balanced, with fine acidity and persistent length.

**133 Chante Cigale Chateaufeuf du Pape - France £55**

This is a traditional Châteaufeuf-du-Pape with a peppery, leathery nose. The palate is dry with spices, more pepper and a hint of vanilla before a delicious, firm finish.

**134 Bramere Cabernet Sauvignon - Argentina £55**

Deep black garnet in colour, this Cabernet Sauvignon from Lujan de Cuyo has aromas of blackcurrant and hints of cedar and dried herbs. Fabulously long finish.
