Professor Vieths is member of several scientific societies, including the German and European Societies of Allergy and Clinical Immunology (EAACI and DGKI) and the German Chemical Society (Gesellschaft Deutscher Chemiker GDCh). He served as member of numerous national and international working groups and committees, including the Executive Committee of the EAACI from 2008 to 2011. He is registered Expert of the European Medicines Agency and the European Pharmacopeia Commission and has been holding the position of Chair of its Allergens Working Party since 2017. He has been member of the WHO/IUIS Allergen Nomenclature Subcommittee since 2006 and Chair of the WHO/IUIS Allergen Standardization Subcommittee since 2005.

Professor Vieths regularly serves as ad hoc reviewer for many peer reviewed journals and funding organizations and acted as Senior Editor or Associate Editor of

scientific journals, such as *Molecular Nutrition and Food Research*, *Clinical and Experimental Allergy*, and *Current Allergy and Asthma Reports*. He has been chairing the conference series “International Paul-Ehrlich-Seminar – Allergen Products for Diagnosis and Therapy: Regulation and Science” since 2002 and has been invited to be a member of programme committees for several other national and international conferences. He is author/co-author of more than 230 original publications as well as more than 75 review articles and position papers in peer-reviewed specialist journals.
