PROJECT UPDATE

Welcome to the latest neighbourhood update for Phase 1 of City Wharf. Since our last newsletter, progress on site has continued at pace, with several key milestones reached across the building.

Externally, all scaffolding has now been removed, with the exception of areas retained for hoist access. This marks a significant step forward in revealing the completed façade. Landscaping works have also commenced, beginning to shape the external spaces around the development.

Inside, activity remains focused on the upper and middle floors. Joinery works have progressed on Level 7, while Level 6 is nearing completion, with furniture installation almost finalised and decoration works ongoing. Mechanical and electrical systems are also entering their final stages, with testing and commissioning underway on Level 2.

The handover of the show flats took place at the end of February, marking an important milestone as we move closer to overall completion.

This continued progress reflects the dedication of our on-site team and the wider network of contractors and suppliers supporting delivery of the scheme.

Community Initiatives

In Glasgow, we continue to support initiatives that create meaningful local impact.

Primary and secondary schools near City Wharf have taken part in our School Outreach Programme, delivered in partnership with The School Outreach Company. Younger pupils explored themes of energy use and carbon through interactive workshops, while older students were introduced to career pathways within construction and real estate. The programme runs throughout the academic year, helping to broaden awareness of opportunities within the built environment.



We also continue our valued partnership with The Clutha Trust. Ongoing support has enabled a range of arts programmes, food support initiatives and inclusive events for vulnerable individuals. In 2025, this included a Christmas dinner for residents and sponsorship of a Winter Wonderland at Blackfriars Primary School, helping to bring festive cheer to local families.

We're proud to play a small part in sustaining their efforts, helping ensure their work continues to bring creativity and connection to the heart of Glasgow.
