## levi's workshop

It's no coincidence that **Levi's** inaugural Workshop is in the heart of San Francisco: The denim brand's oldest remaining factory, built in 1906, is just three blocks away from the temporary pop-up, which opens this month on Valencia Street. The idea behind the Workshops—a series of short-term stores around the world, the second of which opens in New York City in September—is to return to Levi's workwear roots which go back nearly 150 years. The space officially serves as a functioning print shop, with West Coast luminaries like Alice Waters, Aaron Rose, Dave Eggers, and No Age passing through to use the equipment (on Sundays the machines open up to the public, with free printing workshops), but that doesn't mean you'll leave empty handed. The reissued 201 jeans and trucker jackets that line the walls are up for sale, with all profits going to three local charities. "This program is designed to showcase and highlight the work of today's pioneering individuals," says Levi's head of collaborations, partnerships, and creative concepts, Joshua Katz.
