

# New House Textiles

## Where inspiration meets tradition

With roots going back over 100yrs, New House is one of the UK's great small textile businesses. Still run by the same family and completely independent, it operates from picturesque 300-year-old buildings in rural Herefordshire.

This collection has been created by New House's Royal College of Art trained designers who have incorporated a carefully considered colour palette, subtle print designs and textures that have been inspired by nature.

New House is a small but global company whose weaves, prints and sheers are produced in collaboration with exemplary textile companies in Sweden, UK, Japan and the Commonwealth that New House have worked closely with over many years.

## **Environment**

Environmental issues are always high in NHT's thinking. Over 70% of the fabrics in this collection are manufactured either CO<sup>2</sup> neutral, or with recycled yarns.

The binder for this collection is made from polypropylene (a material that can be recycled up to 60 times) while New House's energy comes from surplus wood from the Herefordshire woodland close to our building.
