


HALO by NEW HOUSE TEXTILES


Machined from solid aluminium, Halo is finished in either anodised silver, or white, cream or grey powder-coated paint finish.

It can be painted in any RAL colour for a minimum of 100 items.


Halo has passed EN16434:2012




1. Rear of Halo, showing polypropylene back plate.



2. Slide the back plate open to insert the chain.



3. Slide back plate closed to trap chain and tighten screw.



4. Screw Halo to wall with single main screw
* ensure the Halo device is installed so that the cord or chain is under constant tension.




Child Safety Device - Instructions



1. Drill hole in wall and insert rawl plug.



2. Secure cord against wall and screw safety device holder into place.



3. Slide decorative shape onto rail.
